- Resident looking for assurance from Saanich that there will be no more multi family dwellings on the street.
- Yves suggests sending letter to saanich with results of survey and ask why this application needs a rezoning. Caleb points out that the reasons for rezoning were mentioned in the applicant's letter that accompanied the survey. A CCA letter to council summarizing the concerns and results of the survey will indeed be drafted and circulated to board.
